Crop	Pests	Season	Pints per acre
Grapes	Powdery Mildew	Fall, Late Dormant	1.0 – 3.0

Use Notes:

Begin applications at bud break with subsequent applications throughout the season depending on disease severity. Use the higher rates when conditions favor disease.

Do not apply more than 3 pints/A per application. Do not exceed a total of 30 pints/A per crop per season. Allow a minimum of 3 days between applications

Foliage injury may occur on copper sensitive varieties such as Concord, Delaware, Niagara and Rosette.
