DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control foam before it forms, add one (1) ounce of **FOAMBUSTER® 10** to one hundred (100) gallons of aqueous carrier before pesticides or any other product is added to the spray tank. To control foam that has already formed in the tank, add one (1) to two and one-half (2.5) ounces of **FOAMBUSTER® 10**.

The foaming characteristics of a tank mix also may reflect the hardness of the water being used. Very soft water (low hardness) will require a larger amount of **FOAMBUSTER® 10** than the rates above to control foam. In areas where soft water is prevalent, it is recommended that a small mixture of tank ingredients be combined to determine the correct dosage of **FOAMBUSTER® 10**.


