STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

We recommend storing pails a maximum of three pails high. Do not stack pallets. Store container tightly closed in a cool/well-ventilated dry place protected from sunlight above 40°F. Do not allow container to freeze. Store locked up. **DISPOSE** of contents/container at a permitted facility or as advised by your local regulatory authority. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not apply directly to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. GENERAL INFORMATION

ACTION contains immediately available forms of the essential plant nutrient calcium. Apply **ACTION** to the seed, soil or crop foliage for uptake by the plant.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It may be a violation of federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

ACTION can be applied as a seed treatment, in-furrow, transplant water or drench, as a side-dress or foliar application, and through flood, drip, overhead, pivot and micro irrigation systems. Apply the recommended amount in a volume sufficient to provide uniform coverage.

RECOMMENDED USES

FOR FOLIAR APPLICATION -- Apply to the plant foliage by spraying every 7 to 21 days using 0.5 to 1.0 pint per planted acre. Repeat as needed.

FOR FERTIGATION – Apply through irrigation system every 7-21 days using 0.5 to 1 pint per planted acre. Repeat as needed.

TRANSPLANTS -- Apply as a root dip or drench at 4 to 8 ounces per 100 gallons of water immediately before or after planting.

SEED TREATMENTS – For large-seeded crops, apply as seed treatment at 4 to 8 ounces per 100 pounds of seed. For small-seeded crops, apply 4 to 8 ounces in furrow per planted acre.

*Do not use treated seed for food, feed, or oil purposes. Label treated seed in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Seed Act and applicable state and local laws. Use an approved dye to distinguish treated seed and prevent inadvertent use for food, feed or oil purposes.

FIELD CROPS -- Alfalfa, bean crops, canola, clover, corn, cotton, forage grasses, peanut, potato, rape (canola), rice, sorghum, soybean, sugar beet, sugarcane, sunflower, tobacco, and wheat, barley, oat, or other cereal grain.

VEGETABLE CROPS -- Artichoke, asparagus, broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, kale, and other cruciferous vegetables; leaf lettuce, head lettuce, dandelion, radicchio, and other leafy vegetables; cucumber, melon, pumpkin, squash, and other cucurbits, onion, garlic, and other bulb vegetables; tomato, pepper, eggplant and other fruiting vegetables; strawberry; carrot, potato, sweet potato, radish, beet and other root and tuber vegetables.

FRUIT AND NUT CROPS -- Apple, avocado, blueberry and other bush berries, blackberry, raspberry and other cane berries, sweet orange, lemon, mandarin and other citrus, date palm, fig, grapes, hops, oil palm, olive, persimmon, cherry, peach, plums, prune, nectarine, apricot and other stone fruit, almond, pecan, pistachio, walnut and other tree nuts, pear, pomegranate, and subtropical fruit.

MIXING INSTRUCTION: Follow this mixing order 1. Water 2. ACTION 3. Pesticide. ACTION will disperse in water with little agitation. ACTION is compatible with many fertilizers and pesticides use caution when mixing with phosphorus or sulfur containing fertilizers or other chemicals known to react with calcium. Always conduct a jar test when using new or untried combinations.
