4. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do, then continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice or attention.

SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water until no odor remains. If redness or swelling develops, obtain medical assistance.

INGESTION: Call a physician immediately. Unless advised otherwise by a poison control center or doctor, have person rinse mouth with water, if able. Only induce vomiting at the instruction of a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Surround and absorb all spills. Material should be collected and disposed in a proper manner. Dike the area to prevent spill from spreading. Soak up spill with a suitable absorbent such as clay, sawdust, or kitty litter. Sweep up absorbed material and place in a chemical waste container for disposal. Wear suitable protective equipment.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING: Keep out of reach of children. Read the label before use. Do not eat, drink, or smoke when using this product. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Keep liquids and vapors away from heat, sparks, and flames. Prevent contact with contaminated clothing. If freezing occurs, that at room temperature. Shake the container frequently to ensure homogeneity. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection, and face protection.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, well-ventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse an empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies. **STORE BETWEEN 40° AND 90°F.**
