5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Flash Point: >110°C (>230°F)

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

This product is classified as having a high potential for reaching surface water via runoff for several months or more after application. A level, well-maintained vegetative buffer strip between areas to which this product is applied and surface water features such as ponds, streams, and springs will reduce the potential loading of azoxystrobin and a degradate of azoxystrobin from runoff water and sediment. Runoff of this product will be reduced by avoiding applications when rainfall or irrigation is expected to occur within 48 hours. Notify State and/or Federal authorities and WestLink Ag Products Company, LLC immediately if you observe any adverse environmental effects due to use of this product.
