This product may be used in dilute or concentrate sprays. Rates Per 100 Gallons or Less of Spray Mix Per Acre for Acaracides, Insecticides and Fungicides: Aerial application; 4-10 ounces; ground sprayers; 4 ounces: Herbicides and Defoliants: 1-4 pints. Add BWC SPREADER-90 to spray tank first.
