4. FIRST AID MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

SMALL SPILLS: Confine and absorb small releases with sand, earth, or other inert absorbent material. Use water spray to dilute to weak fertilizer solution and transfer to suitable containers for possible land application according to label use or for disposal.

LARGE SPILLS: Confine the area to qualified personnel. Shut off the release if safe to do so.
