CROP	PEST	APPLICATION
Oranges, Lemons, Limes, Tangerines, Tangelos and Grapefruit	Katydid	Apply 0.5 to 1.25 lbs. of CARZOL SP per acre as outside coverage spray when thrips appear. For aerial applications, use a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre.
	 Do not apply more than 1.25 lbs. CARZOL SP per acre in one crop season. Do not apply after fruit reach a diameter of one inch. If unharvested grapefruit and Valencia oranges are present from the previous crop, an application may be made to the new crop. However, a preharvest interval of 30 days must be observed for the unharvested crop. Note: If soft brown scale is present in the grove, a suitable scallicide should be applied after the CARZOL SP application.
