Minecto Pro will provide suppression of western flower thrips when applied at 10 fl. oz/A.

It is recommended to target western flower thrips on the foliage to achieve the best control.

• To avoid illegal residues, Minecto Pro **must** be mixed with a non-ionic activator type wetting, spreading and/or penetrating spray adjuvant. Do not use binder or sticker type adjuvants. (See **Section 4.4.5** of the Minecto Pro Section 3 label and see the **Use Restrictions** following the **Fruiting Vegetable Crop Use Directions** section on the Section 3 label.)

Applications should be timed to the most susceptible insect pest stage at locally determined action thresholds, before populations reach damaging levels.

Thorough coverage is essential to obtain the best results. Apply this product diluted in a minimum volume of 20 gal/A by ground or 5 gal/A by air. Under conditions such as high pest populations, dense foliage, or adverse application conditions (such as high temperatures), use a greater volume of water to ensure adequate coverage.
