**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

- It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- This state-specific Section 24(c) labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.
- Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA-registered label for Agri-Mek SC Miticide / Insecticide, EPA Reg No. 100-1351 and this label.

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## **Alfalfa (Grown for Seed)**

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- Apply at 1.75 - 2.25 fluid ounces of product (0.009-0.012 pounds of active ingredient) per acre in a minimum of 20 gals. of water per acre with ground equipment. Apply 1.25 - 2.5 fluid ounces of product (0.007-0.014 pounds of active ingredient) in a minimum of 10 gals. of water per acre by air.
- Add a non-phytotoxic non-ionic activator type wetting, spreading and/or penetrating adjuvant that is compatible with Agri-Mek SC Miticide / Insecticide at concentrations specified on the adjuvant label directions for use. **Do not use binder or sticker type adjuvants.** SYNGENTA recommends the use of a Chemical Producers and Distributors Association-certified adjuvant.
- Make foliar applications when spider mites appear.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 2.5 fluid ounces or more than one (1) application of Agri-Mek SC Miticide / Insecticide per acre in any growing season.

**Note:** To avoid injury to pollinating insects, **DO NOT** apply during bloom if bees are in field area. **DO NOT** apply or allow to drift to blooming crops or weeds when bees are visiting the treatment area.

### **Precautions:**

1. Alfalfa seed from treated fields may not be used for growing sprouts for humans or animal consumption.
2. No part of alfalfa plants that have been treated with this product may be used for feed or food use for eleven (11) months from the date of the last application (this includes grazing) except for Madera, Fresno, Kings, Tulare and Kern counties where fields may be grazed and/or harvested (i.e., baled or green chopped) no sooner than eight (8) months after the last application.
3. The grower is responsible for preventing any part of the treated plant material, including but not limited to green, chop, hay, straw, whole seed and seed screenings, from being used for food or feed use. These products must be disposed of using one of the following methods:
  - a. Dispersal at a controlled dump site
  - b. Incineration
  - c. Use by a cogeneration facility
  - d. Disposal on growers property
4. The grower must provide the seed conditioner with a copy of the attached **SLN # CA-120003** Seed Conditioner Notification stating that the lot of seed being delivered is from alfalfa fields being treated with this product. All seed screenings from fields treated with this product shall be disposed of by the seed conditioner in one of the following ways:
  - a. Dispersal at a controlled dump site
  - b. Incineration
  - c. Use by a cogeneration facility
  - d. Use as soil amendment
  - e. Any other method approved of in writing by the County Agricultural Commissioner

5. A copy of the seed conditioner notification shall remain on file with the grower for a period of not less than two years. A second copy is to be signed by the conditioner and mailed to the County Agricultural Commissioner's office, by the grower, within seven (7) days of delivery of the seed to the conditioner.

Valid until withdrawn, suspended or canceled by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), the manufacturer, the 24(c) registrant, or the Department of Pesticide Regulation.
