GENERAL INFORMATION

Vigor 6 is a manufactured liquid humic. Its use is suggested as a supplement to a regular balanced fertilizer program to enhance yields and improve quality.

COMPATIBILITY

Vigor 6 is compatible with most fertilizers and pesticides. However, a compatibility test is suggested if the desired combination has never before been used. Moderate agitation may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GROUND APPLICATION: Ground application should not exceed 1 quart per gallon of water. Apply there recommended amount of **Vigor 6** with sufficient water to provide the desired coverage. When less than 10 gallons of water per acre is used, a slight burning of foliage may occur.

AERIAL APPLICATION: 7 to 10 gallons of water per acre is sufficient to apply the recommended amount of **Vigor 6**. If less water is used a slight burning of the foliage may occur. Aerial application should not exceed 1 quart per gallon of water to increase crop safety and insure good coverage.

NOTE: Do not use **Vigor 6** with oils, limesulfur and/or highly alkaline spray materials.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

Fill spray tank 1/3 to 1/2 with water. With agitator running add **Vigor 6 Power-Line**. Agitate while adding remaining water and any other fertilizer. Add pesticide last and continue to agitate. Agitate well prior to spraying if mix has been left standing for a short time.

SUGGESTIONS FOR USE

Optimum rate of application will vary between fields, depending on soil PH, organic matter, excess lime, salts, sodium, and soil nutrient content. For best results, follow soil test or plant analysis. **Vigor 6 Power-Line** is intended for use in a balanced fertility program for all crops grown in less than optimum conditions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be stored above 40 F. Be careful not to contaminate water, food, or feed by disposal or storage. All containers should be offered for reconditioning or recycling.
