Restrictions and Limitations

In order to apply **Engenia** to dicamba-tolerant cotton and dicamba-tolerant soybeans in Alabama, the following restrictions apply:

- **Spray Drift Management** - A variety of factors including weather conditions (e.g., wind direction, wind speed, temperature, relative humidity) and method of application (e.g., ground, aerial airstream) can influence pesticide drift. The applicator must evaluate all factors and make appropriate adjustments when applying this product.

- **Wind Speed** – **DO NOT** apply at wind speeds greater than 10 mph.
- **Training** – The certified applicator responsible for the application of this product on dicamba-tolerant cotton or dicamba-tolerant soybeans, must attend Auxin Herbicides –Best Management Practices training that is approved by the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries. For more information on this training contact the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries at 334-240-7242 or the Alabama Cooperative Extension System (ACES) office.

The applicator must also consult sensitive crop registries to identify any commercial specialty or certified organic crops that may be located near the application site.

DO NOT apply this product when the wind is blowing toward adjacent dicamba sensitive crops, including but not limited to, peaches, grapes, watermelon, sweet potato, peanut, pepper, beans, non-dicamba tolerant cotton, and non-dicamba tolerant soybean, commercially grown tomatoes, EPA crop group 8 (fruiting vegetables such as tomato, pepper, eggplant, others) and EPA crop group 9 (cucurbit vegetables such as cantaloupe, cucumber, pumpkin, squash, watermelon, others).
