DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ALFALFA (Grown for Seed Purposes Only)

For the control of the two-spotted mite complex.

Ground Application

Use 1½ to 2½ pints of COMITE per acre in 25 to 40 gallons of water per acre.

Aerial Application

Use 1½ to 2½ pints of COMITE in a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre.

Restricted Entry Interval: Observe an REI of 9 days.

NOTE:

Do not make more than two applications per season. Allow at least 14 days between applications.

The state of Idaho rules governing Pesticide Use and Application, IDAPA 02.02.03.800, address this Pesticide Use on Alfalfa Seed and Clover Seed. All restrictions mentioned in these Rules must be followed by anyone making an application covered by this SLN-ID-960016.

No tolerance has been established in association with this use.

The feeding of treated foliage, alfalfa trash or seed screenings to livestock and the grazing of treated fields is prohibited.

All alfalfa seed grown or conditioned as a non-food or non-feed site in the state of Idaho shall bear a tag or a container label which forbids the use of seed for human consumption or animal food. It shall be the grower's responsibility to notify the processing plants of any seed crop treated with COMITE.

No alfalfa seed grown or conditioned as a non-food or non-feed site in the state of Idaho may be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.

The cutting of the current year's alfalfa seed crop for hay or forage, the grazing of the current year's alfalfa seed crop, and the sprouting of treated alfalfa seeds are prohibited.

COMITE is not hazardous to bees when used alone. However, bee hazards may be encountered when combined with other pesticides. Observe State Department of Agriculture regulations on the use of insecticides for seed alfalfa.

COMITE is compatible with most insecticides. Check COMITE label and information handbook for details.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA registered label.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of the pesticide application.
