# For Use on Rhubarb as a Dormant Application to Control Broadleaf Weeds

This label is valid until December 31, 2019 or until otherwise amended, withdrawn, canceled, or suspended.

### **Environmental Hazards**

This pesticide is toxic to marine/estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. # Rhubarb

Before applying Zeus XC to rhubarb, users, producers, and/or applicators must read and follow the information presented in the Manufacturer's Conditions and Risk of Use section at the end of this label.

Use higher rates for soils of pH less than 7.0 and lower rates for pH greater that 7.0 within the rate range.

Apply 8.0 fl oz (0.25 lb ai) of Zeus XC per acre as a broadcast treatment just prior to rhubarb plants breaking dormancy. Apply to rhubarb crowns that have been established for at least one year.

Apply before weeds emerge. Use a minimum of 10 to 40 gallons of finished spray per acre. Zeus XC may be applied with other pesticides registered for use in rhubarb. Use a minimum of 10 gallons of finished spray solution per acre. Zeus XC may be applied with other pesticides registered for rhubarb.

# **Precautions:**
