INGREDIENTS

Proprietary blend of alkanooates and nonionic surfactant. 100%

Ingredients are exempt from tolerance under 40 CFR 180.001 (c&d)

Contains no NPE or APE

USE RATE

Follow pesticide label recommendations for COC.

1-8 quarts per 100 gal spray mix.

For certain in crop applications, lower rates such as these may be needed 4- 25 oz per acre.

GENERAL INFORMATION

EGE COC is a uniquely designed 83/17 crop oil concentrate. The high performing surfactant reduces the surface tension of the spray mix, allowing it to wet and uniformly cover the intended target. EGE COC's humectant properties will extend the dry time of the applied herbicide, and in result, increase the absorption of active ingredients through the plant's cuticle. EGE COC is low phytotoxic and is compatible with fertilizers including AMS. Use when a COC is required with post emergence herbicides, desiccants, defoliants, and other pesticides.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mixing Instructions: Start with a clean spray tank. EGE COC should be added to the tank according to mixing order recommended on the pesticide product label. Agitate while mixing and during spraying. Generally add EGE COC after pesticides have been added and thoroughly mixed. Seller makes no warranty of fitness or merchantability. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Wash hands and other exposed areas with mild soap and water before eating, drinking or smoking and when leaving work. Provide good ventilation in process area to prevent formation of vapour. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Keep container tightly closed in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated place. Protect from sunlight. Personal protective equipment: Wear chemical-resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and shoes.

FIRST AID

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin with water for at least 15 minutes.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing.

IF SWALLOWED: rinse mouth thoroughly. Do not induce vomiting without advice from POISON CONTROL CENTER: 800-222-1222. Get medical attention if you feel unwell.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.
