To call for no antihelmintic is indicated. Contact your veterinarian to be explained in detail or (if you do not understand the label, first someone to explain it to you in detail)

FIRST AID

if swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
if inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
if in eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
if on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Preventing Nettle: Never treat cattle or horses or horses after exposure. For incidents involving animals, seek veterinary care as soon as possible after exposure. Have the product container on hand with you when you call a poison control center or doctor or veterinarian, or when going for treatment. Metaldehyde is a systemic toxic. There is no antidote. The following instructions are not intended for hypothermia. There is no home treatment. Exposed individuals and animals should receive emergency care as quickly as possible.

Notes to Veterinarian: First treatment is used to treat acute exposure, the product is easily repeated. Treatment is symptomatic and supportive. Monitor animals' respiratory, circulatory, electrolyte imbalances, acidosis, dehydration, and increased body temperature have been reported.

Note to Veterinarian: Animals typically are exposed via ingestion. Treatment is symptomatic and supportive. If significant ingestion is suspected, and the animal is asymptomatic, consider induction of emesis or gastric lavage and administration of activated charcoal, cathartic and enemas to limit absorption. Monitor asymptomatic and symptomatic animals closely. That seizure, electrolyte imbalances, acidosis, dehydration, and increased body temperature. Monitor liver function test weekly.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Wear: boots, socks, and other handwear must wear:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Shorts (14 mil)
- Chemical resistant gloves made of barrier laminate, butyl rubber 24 mils, nitrile rubber 14 mils, neoprene rubber 24 mils, natural rubber 24 mils, polyethylene, polypropylene 24 mils, or vinyl 24 mils.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to mollusks (e.g., clams, oysters, mussels, snails). Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. DRR and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate. This pesticide is toxic to birds and mammals. Caution on soil surface may be hazardous to terrestrial wildlife. Cover or collect any such materials spilled during loading.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Read entire label before using. This product is solely for use on agricultural crops grown for commercial or research purposes, and in State and/or Federal invasive mollusk eradication operations. This product may not be applied to residential lawns, lawns, parks, gardens, around homes and apartment buildings, playgrounds, parks, recreation areas, etc.

Broadcast applications and applications of this product directed to plant parts are prohibited except to grass (green for seed and/or storage and hay), corn, clover (green for seed), and as specified for use in State and/or Federal invasive mollusk eradication operations.

FOR STATE AND/OR FEDERAL INVASIVE MOLLUSK ERADICATION OPERATIONS

This product may be used only on the following use sites in response to State and/or Federal invasive mollusk eradication operations:

Approved applications of this product may be made to the following use sites for State and/or Federal invasive mollusk eradication operations: Bare soil; barrier strips; uncultivated non-agricultural areas; recreational areas; non-food or non-feed crops; weed or dense vegetative areas; cultural practices; highway, power and telephone rights of way and railroads; quarries and fences; lumberyards; storage areas; seaports; industrial facility sites, including yards and walkways around industrial buildings; parking areas; parks; golf courses; other public areas; and airports and similar industrial non-crop areas.

This product may be applied for State and/or Federal invasive mollusk eradication operations at an individual application rate of no more than 2 lb. a.i./a. and at no more than 6 applications/year.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS
