Refer to the Blackhawk product label for General Use Precautions, Mixing Directions and Application Directions. Blackhawk should be used as part of an integrated program to manage potato tuberworm which may require multiple applications.

Application Timing and Coverage: Treat in accordance with local economic thresholds. Consult your Dow AgroSciences representative, extension service specialist, certified crop advisor or your state agricultural experiment station for any additional local use recommendations for your area. Application coverage is important for potato tubeworm management, regardless of method used. Ensure coverage is optimized.

Blackhawk is a Group 5 insecticide (spinosad and spinetoram active ingredients). Do not make more than four applications of a Group 5 insecticide per crop. It is also recommended in the case of potato tuberworm to not make more than two consecutive applications of a Group 5 insecticide. Follow additional resistance management recommendations on the product label.

Restrictions:

- Preharvest Interval: Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
- Minimum Treatment Interval: Do not make applications less than 7 days apart.
- Do not apply more than a total of 14.4 oz of Blackhawk (0.33 lb ai of spinosad) per acre per year.
- Maximum Number of Applications: Do not make more than four applications per acre per year.
