Apply only as directed. Apply during the growing season. Andersons Golf Products Turf Fertilizer 10-5-25 supplies a high level of potassium from potassium sulfate for soils low in this nutrient. Adequate potassium levels help promote root development and resistance to stress.

This product should be used when a soil test has been conducted, within the last 36 months, and the test indicates that the soil is deficient in plant available phosphorous or the intended use is for establishing grass or repairing damaged grass during the growing season in which the grass is established.

LOW RATE: 2.0 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.
MEDIUM RATE: 4.0 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.

- Apply at the LOW RATE late spring and summer every 4-6 weeks.
 - Apply at the MEDIUM RATE early spring and fall.

- Warm Season Grasses:**
- Apply at the MEDIUM RATE every 4-6 weeks during the period of active growth.
