DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prior to use, read all the directions on this label and on the labels of the manufacturers' products being used with VINCITRO. The manufacturers' labels for specifi-c usage and restrictions has precedence over directions for use referred to on the VINCITRO label. Test for compatibility prior to mixing and application with other chemicals. Always test new tank mix combinations before widespread use. If unsure, check with the manufacturers or contact your local State Extension Service if you have questions. To ensure thorough mixing, it is suggested that you recirculate mini tanks and bulk tanks or shake containers before using. Pre-rinse all tanks, spray lines or containers thoroughly before adding VINCITRO. Increasing tank mix compounds will increase precipitation and phytotoxicity risk.
