Directions for Use

GrazonNext HL controls susceptible broadleaf plants both pre and postemergence. See the GrazonNext HL main label for a list of susceptible weeds.

Precautions

Postemergence applications on newly emerged or established sorghum-sudangrass, teff, crabgrass, and pearl millet are not recommended. Unacceptable injury or death of these grasses may occur with GrazonNext HL applications.

Pre-plant applications for control of susceptible emerged weeds

Apply GrazonNext HL at a maximum of 1.5 pts/acre with a non-ionic surfactant to control susceptible weeds no sooner than 15 days prior to planting tall fescue, orchardgrass, timothy, and annual ryegrass. GrazonNext HL can also be used at 1.5 pts/acre prior to planting sorghum-sudangrass, teff, crabgrass, and pearl millet, but a minimum 30-day interval must be observed between the application and planting.

Post planting applications for control of susceptible emerged weeds

Apply GrazonNext HL at a maximum of 1.5 pts/acre with a non-ionic surfactant to tall fescue, orchardgrass, timothy, and annual ryegrass after seedling plants have at least reached the V3 stage (three collared leaves).
