Apply 1.5 pts. of Reglone Desiccant per acre in 60 to 120 gals. of water per acre. Add 1 to 2 pts of a 75% nonionic spreader per 100 gals. of spray mix. Thorough coverage of tomato vines is required to insure maximum burndown. Do not use dirty or muddy water for Reglone Desiccant dilution as Reglone Desiccant will be inactivated.
