For control or suppression of diseases of winter, spring and durham wheat when applied at reduced dose rates:

For early-season control of Tan Spot, Septoria leaf and glume blotch, leaf rust, stripe rust and stem rust, apply **1-2 fl ozs per acre** of Evito 480 SC when conditions are favorable to disease development. Evito 480 SC can be applied alone, or in combination with other registered herbicides, insecticides or fungicides. When the reduced rate is applied early season, a second application of Evito 480 SC may be required to protect the flag leaf. Environmental conditions and disease development should be used to determine the need for, timing and use rate for additional applications.
