Influence is most effective when applied in concentration as a spray application.

Spray Applied Use Rates per Soil Type at Spray Volume of 10-15 GPA

Coarse: Sand and Loam Type	12-16 oz/A
Medium: Loam and Silt Loam, Sandy Clay Loam	6-20 oz/A
Fine: Sandy Clay, Silt Clay Loam and Clay	4-8 oz/A

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Fill the spray tank with 50% water and add Influence without agitation while filling the remaining water volume. Begin agitation.

When using a pre-mixer or inductor, fill with at least 20% of desired water volume. Unless instructed otherwise by the labels of tank mix partners, add Variant first to the tank spray mix.
