Onion Thrips

Apply by ground or air at 1 to 2 pt/A in at least 5 gal water/A when insects appear in significant numbers. Repeat applications at 5 to 7 day intervals as necessary. For light infestations, use a low rate, increasing the rate as the infestation increases.

Stubby Root Nematodes

In-Furrow Drench Treatment

Apply 3/4 to 1 gal. of Vydate L per acre at planting as an infurrow drench using 100 to 150 gals. of water per acre.

OR

In-Furrow Band Spray Treatment:

Apply 1 1/2 to 2 gals. per acre at planting as an in-furrow band spray using 20 to 50 gals. of water per acre. **OR**

In-Furrow Spray followed by postemergence band Treatments:
