For Use on Strawberries

### Directions for Use

| Crop       | Disease            | Thiram SC Application Rate (Quarts per acre) | Application Instructions   |
|------------|--------------------|--|--|
| Strawberry | Rhizopus Fruit Rot | 2.0  | Beginning at early blossom stage, broadcast 3 to 5 applications at 10-day intervals per crop cycle. Good coverage of strawberry buds, blossoms and developing fruit is required for best results. Do not apply within 1 day of picking |

### Restrictions:

REI: 24 hours

PHI: 24 hours

The maximum single application for strawberries is 2.5 quarts of product per acre per single application (2.6 lbs. a.i. per acre per single application). Limit of 5 applications per year in areas west of the Mississippi River (12.4 quarts of product per year and 13.0 lbs. a.i. per acre per year). Limit to 12 applications per year in areas east of the Mississippi River (29.7 quarts of product per acre per year and 31.2 lbs. a.i. per acre per year).

Leave 25-foot untreated buffer between treatment area and native plant communities and water bodies.

This recommendation is made as permitted under FIFRA Section 2(ee) and has not been submitted to or approved by EPA. Always read and follow all label directions, restrictions and precautions when using any pesticide alone or in tank mix combinations. The most restrictive labeling applies when using a tank mix combination.

This 2(ee) bulletin contains directions for use not on the EPA registered label of Thiram SC. Please refer to the Thiram SC product label for additional information.

This 2(ee) recommendation must be in possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
