This is a recommendation of FIFRA Section 2(ee) as it relates to the use of Omega Fungicide for the suppression of the arachnid pests, Two-spotted Spider Mite, *Tetranychus urticae* Koch. The user must refer to the federally approved label for Omega and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply Omega at 5.5 to 8.0 fl. oz. per Acre (0.17 to 0.25 Lb. ai/A) to provide suppression of mites. Omega, applied late in the growing season, before mite populations have built up, has shown suppression of mites for 3 to 5 days.

Do not apply more than 3.5 pints product per acre per season. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

The user must refer to the federally approved label and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.

The user should have this recommendation in its possession at the time of use.

This recommendation is made as permitted by Section 2(ee) of FIFRA, as amended, and has not been submitted to or approved by the EPA.
