

# 10% BORON (N.S.)



## GENERAL INFORMATION

**POWER-LINE 10% Boron (N.S.)** is a manufactured liquid nutrient intended for soil application. Its use is suggested as a supplement to a regular balanced fertilizer program to enhance yields and improve quality.

## COMPATIBILITY

**POWER-LINE 10% Boron (N.S.)** is compatible with most fertilizers and pesticides. However, a compatibility test is suggested if the desired combination has never before been used.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**GROUND APPLICATION:** Apply up to 3 gallons per acre of

**POWER-LINE 10% Boron (N.S.)** in sufficient water to provide the desired coverage.

**NOTE:** One gallons of **POWER-LINE 10% Boron (N.S.)** contains .64 units of Boron.

### IMPORTANT NOTE:

Contains Boron. Do not use on Boron Sensitive Crops. Use only according to manufacture's directions.
