GENERAL INFORMATION

PRO-LONG™ is a quality sticking and extending agent, intended for use with most crop protection products, in which the label permits the use of a spreader sticker. PRO-LONG™ is compatible in spray solutions, with most commercial crop protection and foliar feed micronutrients. A thin coating of PRO-LONG™ solution increases pesticide retention by bonding the pesticide to the crop foliage. This retention property decreases the risk of residue erosion from rainfall or irrigation. PRO-LONG™ contains a UV inhibitor which will help reduce damage due to sunlight. Under normal conditions, PRO-LONG™ offers approximately 7 days of extension with a 4 to 6 ounce rate (see below).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add PRO-LONG™ to the spray tank as it is filling, with the agitator running. Under most circumstances, apply solution with PRO-LONG™ a minimum of one hour, during sun up, before an expected rainfall. Sunlight during this time frame is necessary to create the bond.

Use of PRO-LONG™ with pesticides may produce visible residues. If this is a potential problem the PRO-LONG™ rate may be reduced or the addition of PRO-LONG™ should be suspended at or near harvest. PRO-LONG™ has NO LIMITATIONS on non-food crops.

Personal Protective Equipment: Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks when mixing or applying PRO-LONG™

- To increase the efficiency of insecticidal, fungicidal and herbicide sprays, use 4 to 6 oz. of PRO-LONG per acre. To ensure maximum activity of glyphosate, add PRO-LONG to the spray mix at the rate of 4 to 6 oz. per acre
- For use in air blast, free sprayers or hydraulic gun type sprayers, use at the rate of 4 to 6 oz. per 100 gallons of water.
- When applied by aircraft, use at the rate of 4 to 6 oz. per acre for all applications.
- To ensure maximum absorption of Foliar Nutrient Sprays, use 4 oz. of PRO-LONG per acre.

This product cannot be used for Aquatic Applications.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep in original container. Product will become thicker in cooler temperatures but will not adversely affect formulation. Under cool conditions warm product before use. Do not reuse empty container. Puncture and dispose of rinsed container in a sanitary landfill or dispose of container in a safe manner in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal.
