

Cherry Cracking Suppressant

RainGard™ is applied as a protective film on cherries to decrease uptake of rain water by the fruit. RainGard helps maintain cuticle integrity throughout the final stages of fruit growth, thus reducing cracking susceptibility.

CAUTION Keep Out Of Reach Of Children

This product is a mild irritant. Eye contact will cause minor irritation. FIRST AID

If in Eyes: Flush with large amounts of water, lifting upper and lower lids occasionally. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on Skin: Wash exposed areas thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and launder before reuse. If skin feels slippery, continue washing until slick feeling is gone. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

If Swallowed: Give large quantities of water. DO NOT induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs administer additional fluids. Contact a physician for further directions. Never give anything by mouth to an uncon-

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

Mixing:

- 1. Fill clean spray tank with half of the required water. Always use clean water.
- 2. With the agitator running, slowly add RainGard to the tank. Use 102 ounces of RainGard for each 100 gallons of water to obtain a 0.8% V/V final solution, or mix one 6.4 gallon pail of RainGard with 800 gallons of water.
- 3. Add the remaining water to reach the desired dilution.

APPLICATIONS: For maximum efficacy, all cherries must be covered with RainGard. To ensure better coverage, the ground speed of the sprayer should not exceed 2 miles per hour during spraying. Apply 100 gallons per acre of finished spray by airblast or boom sprayer to the trees. If larger spray volumes are chosen, a 0.8% dilution must still be maintained.

When to apply:

Apply the first application of RainGard 4 weeks before estimated harvest date. Reapply RainGard at 7-10 day intervals. Application timing can be slightly modified according to weather forecast in order to anticipate rain events. Always use RainGard in a 3-weekly applications program. Single applications of RainGard, before a rain event, have been proven to be less effective in reducing rain cracking when compared to the 3 weekly application program, and they are not recommended.

TANK MIXES: RainGard is usually compatible with commonly used agricultural products and can be tank mixed. Please contact your field representative for advice on mixing with specific products.

CLEAN-UP: Clean sprayer tank and nozzles immediately after use by adding clean water to the spray tank and spraying the water through the nozzles.

STORAGE & HANDLING

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place above 45°F but away from direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children and livestock.

SPILLS: Only trained personnel equipped with proper protective gear should be permitted in the area. Stop spill at source. Reclaim material if possible for reuse. Containerize contaminated material for disposal. After all visible traces have been removed, flush area thoroughly with
