Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 is a liquid plant food developed for use as a soil applied and / or starter fertilizer applied with the seed or in the transplant water. Nitrogen, phosphate, and potash help stimulate early root development, plant growth, and fruit set. Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 should be used as the foundation for a balanced nutritional program.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 is designed to maximize nutrient availability in the soil rhizosphere. For best results, concentrate Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 in a pre-plant or side-dress application. It can also be used during the growing season through controlled irrigation systems that do not allow water source contamination from backflow. When applied through an irrigation system Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 must be injected after sand media filters.

Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 has been formulated to provide NPK nutrients to a wide range of crops. Growing conditions may vary rates, timing, and application methods. Use caution when applying to drier, sandy soils. Contact your crop advisor for specific recommendations.

SOIL APPLICATION

General use rates are 1 - 30 gallons per acre through the growing season. Your crop advisor can provide the best advice for application rates that fit local conditions.

BANDING: Apply 1 - 20 gallons per acre in a band 2 - 3 inches below or to the side of the seed at planting.

WITH SEED: Apply 1 - 3 gallons per acre with the seed at planting.

DO NOT exceed 3 gallons per acre with the seed at planting. For cotton, do not exceed 2 gallons per acre at planting.

TRANSPLANT WATER: Add 1 gallon for every 200 gallons of water.

PRE-PLANT INCORPORATED: Apply 5 - 30 gallons per acre in the soil prior to planting per crop advisor recommendation to meet fertility needs.

DECIDUOUS FRUIT AND NUT TREES, OLIVES, CITRUS: Inject 5 - 30 gallons per acre 3 - 5 inches deep at the drip line or surface band and water into soil as needed for crop nutrient demand.

SPRINKLER & DRIP IRRIGATION

Note: High calcium and high bicarbonate irrigation water should be jar tested for compatibility with phosphate containing fertilizers. **DISCONTINUE USE IF PRECIPITATION OCCURS.**

Rhizoburst Gold 8-28-3 has been formulated to allow the user to meter over an entire irrigation set or rapidly inject as needed.

ALL CROPS: Use 5 - 30 gallons per acre throughout the growing season.
