STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

GENERAL INFORMATION—FS Interface is a low-use-rate, activator adjuvant blend designed to maximize the performance of glyphosate, and its tank mix partners, on hard-to-control weed species. FS Interface effectively replaces the need for ammonium sulfate with glyphosate and glyphosate tank mixes by sequestering antagonistic hard water ions, maximizing cuticle penetration of both water-soluble and oil-soluble herbicides, and protonating weak acid herbicides for rapid absorption and transportation.

APPLICATION RATES—Apply FS Interface at 2 quarts per 100 gallons or 2 liters per 400 liters of spray solution (0.5% v/v).

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS— FS Interface can be added anytime during the mixing procedure. However, it is best to add FS Interface prior to emulsifiable concentrate (EC) pesticide formulations. In the absence of specific mixing instructions, fill the spray tank ½ to ¾ full of desired water volume. While the water is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

1. If foaming is anticipated, use an antifoam/defoamer.
2. Water-soluble packets, dry flowables, and dispersible granule pesticides.
3. Ammonium sulfate, fertilizers or micronutrients.
4. Flowable pesticides.
5. Water soluble pesticides.
6. FS Interface.
7. EC pesticides.
8. Continue agitation and finish filling spray tank to desired level.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL— Store in original container, in a cool, dry and secure area. Keep container tightly closed and sealed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container thoroughly, disposing of rinsate and the container in accordance with federal, state and local regulations. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option for container disposal. The Agriculture Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates a national recycling program.
