DIRECTIONS

Planting Trees, Bushes, and Other Plants

Fill planting hole with water, add 1 ounce of WATER-IN. After planting is completed, fill the planted area with water, and add 1 ounce of WATER-IN. Let water run slowly for 5 minutes.

Existing Trees or Bushes

Fill the well with water and add 1 ounce of WATER-IN. Soak area thoroughly. Water trees over night.

Wetting Peat Moss, Steer Manure, Sawdust or Mulch

Add 1 tablespoon of WATER-IN to each gallon of water. Pour over 1 gallon of mulch, before or after applying.

Potted Plants

Put 2 drops of WATER-IN in a cup of water, use whenever watering.

Active Ingredient

Alkyl Polyethylene Glycol Ether.....25.0%

Treating Hard Soil, Compacted Areas, Slopes, Lawns & Newly Planted Lawns

Put 1 quart of WATER-IN in a garden hose sprayer. Spray over soil, plants or lawn. Water well for several days. WATER-IN will penetrate deeply. 1 quart covers 1,000 square feet (20 x 50 ft.). For occasional treatment as an aid to keeping ground open: put 1 pint of WATER-IN in a garden hose sprayer, and fill with water. Spray over 1,000 sq. ft. as needed.

WATER-IN is neutral, so it can be used with any product on any soil. WATER-IN breaks the surface tension of water so it will flow into and between the smallest earth particles.
