GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is a general purpose, low foaming, nonionic surfactant used to maximize the effectiveness of herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, and other pesticides. This product incorporates quick wetting and uniform droplet distribution to improve plant coverage and penetration.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Note: Carefully read and follow all directions contained on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. The pesticide label usage directions and rates take precedence over all directions for use referred to on this label.

SUGGESTED USAGE RATES

Herbicides - Use this product at the rate of 1 quart per 100 gallons of spray mixture to obtain a 1/4% of surfactant ratio. Use 2 quarts per 100 gallons of spray mixture to obtain a 1/2% surfactant ratio.

Insecticides and Acaracides - Use this product at a rate of 2 to 8 ounces per 100 gallons of spray mixture.

Defoliants and Dessicants - Use this product at a rate of 1 to 4 pints per 100 gallons of spray mixture

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law and may contaminate groundwater.
