**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**Ad-Here® XL** is designed for use with agricultural fungicides, herbicides and insecticides to speed wetting, give more uniform coverage and improve adhesion between the pesticide and the plant surface. Not for aquatic use.

**RECOMMENDED RATES**

<u>DOSAGE</u>	<u>RATE PER 100 GALLONS OF SPRAY MIX</u>
Herbicides	1 to 3 pints
Insecticides	2 to 8 ounces
Defoliants and Desiccants	1 to 3 pints
Fungicides and Acaricides	2 to 8 ounces
Wettable Powders	6 to 12 ounces

For wettable powders, water soluble materials and emulsifiable liquids add **Ad-Here® XL** to the tank after a good mixture is formed.

**FIRST AID**
