DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Plantex[®] 35-5-10 Soluble Turf Fertilizer is recommended for use on all types of turf. For newly germinated turf or applications in very hot weather, use one half the recommended rate. Use warm water for fastest dissolving. Store in a cool, dry place.

Apply **Plantex**[®] 35-5-10 in sufficient water for uniform coverage. A minimum of 20L of water per 1000ft² (100 m²) is required for proper application.

Apply 3 to 4 times during the season.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

To ensure complete dissolution of this product, we suggest the following procedure when preparing a fertilizer solution:

- 1) Fill the fertilizer tank with half the required amount of warm water before adding fertilizer.
- 2) Add the recommended amount of product to the tank while adding the remaining water required. If possible, provide some agitation to hasten the dissolution of the fertilizer.
- 3) Ensure the fertilizer is completely dissolved before starting pumps to avoid damaging the pump or plugging filters.
