

BLOOM BUILDER

SOLUBLE FERTILIZER 12 - 48 - 8 WITH CHELATED MINORS

A high quality, totally water soluble, high phosphate fertilizer with chelated minor elements. For use in promoting bud formation and set in flowering annuals and vegetable plants. May also be used as a transplant solution for newly set plants to promote root growth.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INDOOR PLANTS: Mix 1 teaspoonful with 1 gallon of water (1/4 tsp. per quart). Use at every watering or at least once each week during flowering period.

OUTDOOR PLANTS: Mix 1 tablespoonful with 1 gallon of water. Soak root area using about 1 gallon of solution per 4 square feet of bed area. Repeat every 1 - 2 weeks during flowering period.

TRANSPLANT SOLUTION: Mix 2 tablespoonfuls per gallon of water. Use 1/2 to 1 pint of solution per plant.

FOLIAR FEED: Use 1 tablespoonful per gallon of water. Use as a thorough cover spray alone or may be combined with most foliar insecticides or fungicides.
