Precautionary Statements

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or smoking tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Personal Protective Equipment: Wear protective eyewear (goggles or face shield), chemical-resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks when mixing or applying Sonic 90.

First Aid

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If On Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

General Information

Sonic 90 provides optimum wetting and spreading of insecticides, fungicides, herbicides, defoliant and desiccants.

Sonic 90 may be used on agricultural, forestry, turf, ornamental, industrial and non-cropland sites.

Not for aquatic use in the state of Washington.

Directions for Use

Before using Sonic 90, always read and follow all label directions, mixing instructions and precautionary statements of the pesticide label that is to be tank mixed with this product.

Suggested Use Rate per 100 Gallons of Spray Mix

Acaricides, Fungicides, Insecticides.....1/2 to 1 pint
Herbicides, Defoliant, Desiccants.....1 to 3 pints
Livestock Sprays.....1/2 pint

Rates of Sonic 90 may vary with the conditions of the application due to recommendations of the pesticide label.

Mixing

Before using Sonic 90, read the entire pesticide label to be tank mixed. All instructions on the pesticide label must be followed.

Fill the spray tank 1/2 to 1/3 full with clean water. Add Sonic 90 before adding pesticide products. For emulsifiable products, add Sonic 90 after emulsion is formed.

Storage and Disposal

Do not store below 40°F or above 120°F.

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal.
