GENERAL INFORMATION

TRACITE® IRON 5% is a chelated micronutrient designed for foliar or soil application. It is recommended for use as an additive in dry or liquid fertilizers and is compatible with most of the herbicides, insecticides and agricultural chemicals that can be utilized in combination with liquid fertilizers. TRACITE® IRON 5% may not be compatible with some liquid fertilizer formulations. A pre-mix "jar test" is recommended prior to mixing with liquid fertilizer to check compatibility.

The addition of TRACITE® IRON 5% to water will decrease alkaline hydrolysis associated with all organo-phosphate insecticides.

RECOMMENDED CROPS

TRACITE® IRON 5% can be applied to the following crops: Vegetables, fruit, row crops, deciduous fruit and nut trees, citrus trees and commercial turf and ornamentals. DO NOT APPLY NEAR WATER, STORM DRAINS, OR DRAINAGE DITCHES. DO NOT APPLY IF HEAVY RAIN IS EXPECTED. APPLY THIS PRODUCT ONLY TO YOUR LAWN/GARDEN.

APPLICATION AND MIXING GUIDE

Rates and timing of applications are dependent on local conditions and should always be made as a result of soil and/or plant tissue analysis and in conjunction with your local agricultural authority.

TRACITE® IRON 5% may be applied by ground or aerial application. Use enough water for thorough uniform coverage of foliage or soil. Thorough coverage is necessary for best results and the addition of a non-ionic surfactant such as INDUCE® is recommended.

Mixing: In any mixing operation, TRACITE® IRON 5% should be introduced in the following sequence:

- Water
- **TRACITE® IRON 5%** 2.
- Fertilizers or pesticides 3

In mixtures where a compatibility agent is suggested, a product such as BLENDEX® VHC is recommended.
