HYDRO-HOLD™ is a concentrated adjuvant designed for use in hydro-seeding
application and other associated erosion control methods. HYDRO-HOLD™ is
formulated with highly active chemistry and engineered with an advanced emulsion
system designed for easy mixing and speedy treatment performance. HYDRO-
HOLD™ can be effectively used in a wide variety of erosion control systems including
mulch application with straw, wood fibers, paper cellulose and virtually any other mulch
media designed for slurry application (bonded fiber matrix).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HYDRO-HOLD™ APPLICATION NOTICE: The directions supplied on this label are
for general guideline purposes. Varied soil types, environmental conditions, slopes,
drainage systems, water quality, and local management practices are all significant
considerations, in determining the optimal rate selection and application technique, for
any given HYDRO-HOLD™ use. Please consult with your local Helena Chemical

pertaining to your hydro-treatment need.

RATE SELECTION

HYDRO SEEDING/MULCH PERFORMANCE ENHANCER

HYDRO-HOLD™ can be mixed directly with fiber/mulch-seed mixes. The addition of
HYDRO-HOLD™ has many potential benefits dependent upon the desired
performance characteristics and subsequent use rate selection. **Refer to mixing and
handling instructions.**

GENERAL PURPOSE USE RATE: 8 to 12 pints per Acre

8 to 12 pints of HYDRO-HOLD™ applied per acre in hydro-mulch application can be
used for general hydro performance enhancement, including improved mixing and
moisture retention and enhanced deposition/mulch coverage. **Refer to mixing and
handling instructions.**

GENERAL PURPOSE USE RATE: 4 to 6 gallons per Acre

HYDRO-HOLD™ may be used at rates as high as 6 gallons per acre to deliver very
high performance tackifier response with extended residual control for more difficult
seed establishment factors such as severe slope, vulnerable soil structures, and/or
minimum maintenance installations. **Refer to mixing and handling instructions.**

only be added after all other components have been added and the mixing process
has begun. Agitate and mix thoroughly to insure uniform exposure and maximized
consistency.
