Directions for Use

Apply only as directed. For use on turf, in gardens, and around trees, shrubs and flowers. This product is pH neutral and will not increase soil pH. It may lower or reduce the soil pH of unproductive, highly alkaline sodium soils.

Applied to saline-sodic soils, the gypsum will loosen the heavy, hard packed soil, allowing water and air to penetrate and move freely in the soil.

When establishing a new turf area, apply 40-100 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. prior to seeding. Till or rake thoroughly into the top 3" of soil. Water well after application. High clay soils will require a higher rate.

For corrective action on established turf areas, apply 25-40 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. in the Spring and Fall. On higher clay or heavily compacted soils, apply 80 to 130 lbs. of product.

Apply 6 to 12 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. to maintain proper soil conditions on established turf. Apply 1 to 2 times per year, in the spring and fall.

For gardens, mix in 10-20 lbs. per 100 sq. feet. Place 1-2 cups around each rose bush in the Spring and Fall. For trees, shrubs and flowers, apply 2-4 cups around the base of smaller plants and 4-6 cups around the base of larger plants.

To repair larger areas damaged from winter salt and fertilizer apply 20-40 lbs. per 10 sq. feet. For smaller areas, such as animal spots, apply 1/2 - 3/4 cup per square foot.

To aid in the generation of compost, spread approximately 2 cups over the top of the material in the cart as it is dumped into the compost pile.

Treat daily, adding 2 cups per day until the compost is complete. This will take approximately 1 1/2 weeks.

For all applications, water the area well after application.
