GENERAL INFORMATION

New York Use Restrictions: In New York State this product may only be used by professional applicators and at a maximum of 10 pounds per 1000 square feet (equivalent to 0.5 pounds active ingredient per acre) per year, and is prohibited from use in Nassau and Suffolk Counties.

USE PRECAUTIONS

This product is a herbicide that provides control of broadleaf and other annual grasses and broadleaf weeds in established lawns and ornamental plants, including golf course fairways, roughs, and tee boxes. This product will not harm nearby established ornamentals when used according to label directions.

TURFGRASS SAFETY

Turfgrass Safety: The product may be used to control selected or sprayed annual grasses and ornamental turf that are well-established. The grass must have received 2 to 4 growth cycles. It is a good idea to wait until after the first two mowings before applying. Use of this product on lawns and ornamentals that have not been weakened by weather, pest, disease, chemical, or mechanical-related stress, may increase the chances for turf injury.

This product should only be applied to lawns and ornamental turf that are composed of the following turfgrass species that have been determined to be tolerant to applications of this product. When applied as directed under the conditions described, the following established turfgrasses are believed to be tolerant to this product:

Cool-Season Grasses

Bentgrass, creeping (*Agrostis palustris*)
Bluegrass, Kentucky (*Poa pratensis*)
Fescue, tall (*Festuca arundinacea*)
Ryegrass, perennial (*Lolium perenne*)

Warm-Season Grasses

Bermudagrass (*Cynodon dactylon*)

this product will also control at the "Program 3 rates" or suppress grasses ("Program 2 rates") the following (the following weeks after application):

- (a) for the first 2 weeks after application to the ground, bentgrass, crabgrass, Johnson grass, and annual ryegrass.
- (b) for the first 4 weeks after application to the ground, annual ryegrass, crabgrass, and annual bluegrass.
- (c) for the first 6 weeks after application to the ground, annual ryegrass, crabgrass, and annual bluegrass.
- (d) for the first 8 weeks after application to the ground, annual ryegrass, crabgrass, and annual bluegrass.

APPLICATION EQUIPMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS

Apply this product with drop or rotary type spreaders designed to apply granular herbicides. Avoid the use of spreaders that would leave application patterns or droplets on the ground due to the equipment manufacturers directions for adjusting the spreader setting such that the spreader delivers the appropriate application rate recommended above. Apply this product uniformly over the lawn or ornamental turf area. An uneven application can be made by spreading the seed across the lawn at a high angle to the previous application.
