PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Before using this product, read the entire label, including the condition of sale.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting unless directed to do so by medical personnel. Seek medical attention. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If In Eyes:	Flush with water for 15 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
If On Skin:	Wash the affected area with water for 15 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
If Inhaled:	Remove person to fresh air. If cough or other respiratory symptoms develop, seek medical attention.

GENERAL INFORMATION

NITROIL is a proprietary blend of high quality 32% nitrogen, paraffinic oil and a non-ionic surfactant blend for use with post-emergence herbicides under a variety of environmental conditions. When used at recommended rates, this product can increase the performance of those herbicides, for which the addition of 28% nitrogen solutions is recommended.

This product will help enhance the herbicide activity of certain post-emergence herbicides when used at the proper rate.

The enhanced herbicide performance resulting from the use of this product may be more apparent in situations of environmental stress.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add this product to the spray tank at the rate specified by the label of the herbicide to be used. Before mixing the selected herbicide with this product in a spray tank, it is recommended that a compatibility test be done in a small (1 quart) container to determine if the components of the spray tank are compatible. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.**

Note: Always read herbicide label for recommended rate of oil plus nitrogen to determine proper amount of this product to be used.

USE RATES

Per acre: 0.5–1 gallons per acre. A use rate of 2 quarts per acre meets the requirements of most herbicides that require UAN and COC adjuvant combinations.

By volume: 2–4 gallons per 100 gallons of solution (2–4% v/v)

Add NITROIL to the spray tank at the rate specified by the label of the herbicide to be used.

1 gallon of Nitroil contains the equivalent of 1 quart of crop oil plus 4 quarts of liquid nitrogen.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Add 1/2 the amount of water to the spray tank and begin agitation. Add the recommended amount of this product and herbicide to the spray tank. Add the remainder of the water required and continue agitation until all solution has been applied.

NITROGEN AND OIL ACTIVITY LEVEL

The activity level in 1 gallon of this product is equal to 1 quart of crop oil, plus 4 quarts of 28% nitrogen.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container only. Keep container tightly closed. Do not allow water to be introduced into contents of this container. Do not contaminate water sources by runoff from cleaning of equipment, disposal of equipment wash-waters or spray waste. Do not store near heat or open flame. Triple rinse (or equivalent) empty container and add rinsate to spray tank, then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of according to State and Local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.
