FIRST AID

Spectrasol® Disinfectant is a phosphate-free, pH neutral formulation designed to provide effective cleaning, deodorizing, and disinfection for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants, food service establishments, transportation terminals, office buildings, manufacturing facilities, lodging establishments, retail businesses, athletic facilities, sports stadiums, amphitheaters and convention centers where housekeeping is of prime importance in controlling cross-contamination from treated surfaces.

Spectrasol® Disinfectant, when used as directed, is formulated to disinfect the following hard non-porous inanimate environmental surfaces: Floors, walls, metal surfaces, stainless steel surfaces, glazed porcelain, glazed ceramic tile, plastic surfaces, artificial turf surfaces, vanity tops, shower stalls, bathtubs, and cabinets.

Spectrasol® Disinfectant is for use in:

- Food processing plants, dairy farms, hog farms, poultry and turkey farms and egg processing plants.
- Veterinary clinics, animal life science laboratories, kennels and cages, breeding and grooming establishments, pet animal quarters, zoos, pet shops, and other animal care facilities.
- For larger areas such as operating rooms and patient care facilities, this product is designed to provide both general cleaning and disinfecting.

Spectrasol® Disinfectant is a one-step neutral disinfectant that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is virucidal* (including HIV-1, HIV-2, HBV and HCV) and inhibits the growth of mold and mildew and their odors when used as directed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is not for use on critical and semi-critical medical device surfaces.

GENERAL CLEANING: Apply Spectrasol® Disinfectant to soiled area with a mop, cloth, sponge, hand pump trigger sprayer or low pressure coarse sprayer. Spectrasol® Disinfectant can be diluted at one (1) ounce per gallon or applied at full strength. Thoroughly wet soiled surface and scrub as necessary.

DEODORIZATION: To deodorize, apply Spectrasol® Disinfectant as indicated under the heading DISINFECTION.

DISINFECTION: To disinfect inanimate, hard non-porous surfaces add one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge, hand pump trigger sprayer or low pressure coarse sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. For sprayer applications, spray 6-8 inches from the surface, rub with brush, sponge or cloth. Do not breathe spray mist.

For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required.

Poultry and Swine Premise Disinfection:

Site Preparation: The first step in any on-going disinfection program should be the removal of gross contamination and debris. This may be accomplished using a shovel, broom, or vacuum depending on the area to be disinfected. The efficacy of even the most efficient germicidal cleaner is reduced in the presence of heavy organic matter. Once the heavy debris is eliminated, thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water.

Cleaning and Disinfection: For all general cleaning and disinfection, use one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply Spectrasol® Disinfectant using a cloth, mop or low pressure coarse sprayer so as to thoroughly wet surface to be disinfected. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution after each use.

Applications and Use Dilution:

Poultry, Hatcheries, and Swine Premises: Remove all animals and feeds from premises, trucks, cars, coops and crates. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of facilities occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Use one (1) ounce of

Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water. Saturate surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution for a period of 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub treated feed racks, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse. Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used for removing litter and manure.

Hatcheries: Use one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water to treat the following hard non-porous surfaces: hatchers, setters, trays, racks, carts, sexing tables, delivery trucks and other hard surfaces. Leave all treated surfaces exposed to disinfectant solution wet for 10 minutes or more. Rinse with potable water before reuse. Then allow to air dry. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required.

Vehicles: Clean all vehicles including mats, crates, cabs, and wheels with high pressure water and Spectrasol® Disinfectant. Use one (1) ounce per gallon to treat all vehicles. Leave all treated surfaces exposed to disinfectant solution wet for 10 minutes or more.

Dressing Plant Use: Disinfect equipment, utensils, walls and floors in poultry and animal dressing plants. Disinfect offal rooms, exterior walls and loading platforms of dressing plants. Cover or remove all food and packaging materials. Remove all gross soils. Saturate all surfaces with the recommended use solution, one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water. Scrub to loosen all soils. Allow to soak for 10 minutes and thoroughly rinse all wetted and cleaned surfaces with potable water.

(Not For Use in California)

Directions for Hatchery Rooms Using Fogging Devices:

Remove all animals and feed from premises, vehicles and enclosures. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces of the room to be treated. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Close room off so fog is confined to room to be treated. Mix two parts of Spectrasol® Disinfectant to five parts water (1 gallon of Spectrasol® Disinfectant to 2 ½ gallons of water). Insert the nozzle of the fogger through a suitable opening into the room. With the setting in maximum output, fog for one minute for each 4000 cubic feet of space in the room. When fogging is completed, ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed or dried. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water.

Directions for Incubators and Hatchers Using Fogging Devices:

Mix 12 ounces of Spectrasol® Disinfectant to 122 ounces of water. Fog 3-8 ounces of this into setters and hatchers immediately after transfer. Repeat daily in setters and every 12 hours in hatchers. Discontinue hatcher treatments at least 24 hours prior to pulling the hatch. Do not allow people to contact or breathe this fog and do not enter until the fog has settled (30-60 minutes after fogging is completed). It is acceptable to fog setters and hatchers with a one (1) ounce per

gallon solution of Spectrasol® Disinfectant on an hourly or every other hour basis. If this is done, fog for 30-90 seconds once per hour or once every two hours. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap and detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse.

NOTE: The fog generated is irritating to the eyes, skin and mucous membranes. Under no circumstances should a room or building be entered by anyone within two hours of the actual fogging. If the building must be entered, then the individuals entering the building must wear a self-contained respirator approved by NIOSH/MSHA, goggles, long sleeves and long pants.

FOGGING IS TO BE USED AS AN ADJUNCT TO ACCEPTABLE MANUAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF ROOM AND MACHINE SURFACES.

Farm Premise Use: Do not use in milking stalls, milking parlors or milk houses. Remove all animals and feed from premises, vehicles and enclosures. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate all surfaces with a use-solution of one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water (or equivalent dilution) for a period of 10 minutes. Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used in removing litter and manure. Ventilate buildings, cars, trucks, boats and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with potable water before reuse.

(Not Permitted in California)

Mushroom Farm Sanitation:

This product disinfects, cleans and deodorizes in one step. Recommend for use in mushroom farm sanitation. Apply to surfaces which do not come in contact with the crop, compost or casing. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits using a shovel, broom or vacuum depending on the area to be disinfected. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply this product at one (1) ounce per gallon of water dilution (1:128), thoroughly wetting the surfaces with a mop, sponge, cloth, spraying or soaking. Treated surfaces should remain wet for 10 minutes and let air dry. The recommended use-solution is prepared fresh for each use, then discarded. If greater detergency is required, dilute this product at 2 to 4 ounces per gallon of water. **DO NOT APPLY TO MUSHROOM CROP, COMPOST OR CASING.**

Mushroom Foot Dip for Waterproof Footwear:

Use this product at one (1) ounce per gallon of water in foot dip tray. Shoe baths must contain at least one (1) inch of freshly made solution and should be placed at the entrances to building. Scrape shoes and place in diluted solution for 60 seconds before entering building. Allow shoes to remain wet

for 10 minutes to control mushroom pathogens. Change solution in bath daily or sooner if solution appears dirty.

Mushroom Bactericidal Activity:

When diluted at one (1) ounce per gallon, this product demonstrates effective disinfectant activity against the following mushroom pathogens: *Pseudomonas tolaasii* (Blotch Disease) and *Pseudomonas* spp. (Mummy Disease).

Citrus Canker Control:

For prevention of Citrus Canker Disease through treatment of equipment. Effective against *Xanthomonas axonopodis* pv. *citri* (Citrus Canker) at 2000 ppm active quat. Treat all trucks, vehicles, and equipment thoroughly at a dilution ratio of 1:54 (2000 ppm active quat). Treatment can be applied to trucks, attached trailers, field harvesting equipment; including cargo area, wheels, tires, under carriage, hood, roof, fenders and any other part of transportation equipment that can be taken into infested areas. To prevent the spread of Citrus Canker by this artificial means of transportation, treatments are made by trigger spraying, dipping or brushing, using maximum rate 2000 ppm quat. After use, all surfaces which come in contact with food or crop must be rinsed with potable water.

Veterinary Practice, Animal Care Laboratory, Zoos, Pet Shops, Kennels Disinfection Directions:

For cleaning and disinfecting the following hard non-porous surfaces: equipment not used for animal food or water, utensils, instruments, cages, kennels, stables, catteries, etc. Remove all animals and feed from premises, animal transportation vehicles, crates, etc. Remove all litter, droppings and manure from floors, walls and surfaces occupied or traversed by animals. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate surfaces with a use-solution of one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water (or equivalent dilution) for a period of 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

To disinfect food processing premises: Floors, walls, and storage areas, add one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge, hand pump trigger sprayer or low pressure coarse sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the area or carefully protected. After use, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water.

To disinfect restaurant food contact surfaces: Countertops, appliances, and tables, add one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant per gallon of water. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply solution with a cloth, sponge or hand pump trigger sprayer or low pressure coarse sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid and rinse surface with potable water. This product cannot be used to clean the following food contact surfaces: utensils, glassware and dishes.

To disinfect toilet bowls: Remove gross filth or soils from surfaces with bowl brush. Add one (1) ounce of Spectrasol® Disinfectant to the bowl water. Brush or swab the bowl completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop making sure to get under the rim. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush.

Non-Acid Toilet Bowl Disinfection/Cleaner Directions: Remove gross filth prior to disinfection.

From Concentrate: Add one (1) ounce per gallon (8 milliliters per liter) to the toilet bowl and mix. Brush thoroughly over exposed surfaces and under the rim, allow to stand for 10 minutes and flush.

From Use-Solution: Empty toilet bowl or urinal and apply one (1) ounce per gallon (8 milliliters per liter) use-solution to exposed surfaces including under the rim with a cloth, mop, sponge, hand pump trigger sprayer or low pressure coarse sprayer. Brush or swab thoroughly. Allow to stand for 10 minutes and flush.

For Heavy Duty Use: Empty toilet bowl or urinal and apply four (4) ounces per gallon (32 milliliters per liter) use-solution to exposed surfaces including under the rim with a cloth, mop, sponge, hand pump trigger sprayer or low pressure coarse sprayer. Brush or swab thoroughly. Allow to stand for 10 minutes and flush.

BACTERICIDAL ACTIVITY: At the one (1) ounce per gallon dilution, Spectrasol® Disinfectant demonstrates effective disinfectant activity against the organisms: *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Salmonella enterica* subsp. *enterica* serotype *choleraesuis*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Staphylococcus aureus* (clinical isolate), *Bordetella bronchiseptica*, *Corynebacterium ammoniagenes*, *Enterobacter aerogenes*, *Enterobacter cloacae*, *Enterobacter cloacae* (clinical isolate), *Enterococcus faecalis*, *Enterococcus faecalis* (clinical isolate), *Escherichia coli*, *Escherichia coli* (clinical isolate), *Fusobacterium necrophorum*, *Klebsiella pneumoniae* subsp. *pneumoniae*, *Lactobacillus casei* subsp. *rhamnosus*, *Listeria monocytogenes*, *Pasteurella multocida*, *Proteus vulgaris*, *Proteus mirabilis* ATCC 9921, *Proteus mirabilis* ATCC 25933, *Salmonella enterica* subsp. *enterica* serotype *paratyphi* B, *Salmonella enterica* subsp. *enterica* serotype *typhi*, *Salmonella enterica* subsp. *enterica* serotype *typhimurium*, *Salmonella enterica* subsp. *enterica* serotype *pullorum*, *Serratia marcescens*, *Shigella sonnei*, *Shigella flexneri* Type 2b, *Shigella dysenteriae*, *Staphylococcus aureus* subsp. *aureus*, *Staphylococcus epidermidis*, *Staphylococcus epidermidis* (clinical isolate), *Streptococcus pyogenes* (Clinical – Flesh Eating Strain BIRD M3), *Streptococcus pyogenes* Group A, *Xanthomonas maltophilia* (clinical isolate), Vancomycin resistant *Enterococcus faecalis* (VRE), Methicillin resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA), Vancomycin intermediate resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (VISA), Community Associated Methicillin resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (CA-MRSA) NRS 123 Genotype USA400, Community Associated Methicillin resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (CA-MRSA) NRS 384 Genotype USA300.

MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew (*Aspergillus niger*) and the odors they cause on pre-cleaned, hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces add one (1) ounce of this product per gallon of water. Apply solution with a cloth, mop, sponge

or hand pump trigger sprayer making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth appears.

FUNGICIDAL ACTIVITY: At the one (1) ounce per gallon dilution, this product is fungicidal against the pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (Athlete's Foot Fungus) and *Candida albicans*. Apply solution with a cloth, sponge or hand pump trigger sprayer to hard, non-porous surfaces found in bathrooms, shower stalls, locker rooms, exercise facilities or other clean, hard non-porous surfaces commonly contacted by bare feet. Allow the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. Diluted product should be applied daily or more frequently with heavy facility use.

***VIRUCIDAL ACTIVITY:** This product, when used on environmental, inanimate, hard non-porous surfaces, exhibits effective virucidal activity against HIV-1, HIV-2, Hepatitis B virus (HBV), Hepatitis C virus (HCV), Herpes Simplex Type 1 (causative agent of fever blisters), Herpes Simplex Type 2 (genital), Influenza A₂/Hong Kong, Vaccinia, Rotavirus, Human Coronavirus (ATCC VR-740, strain 229E), SARS associated Coronavirus, Bovine Viral Diarrhea Virus (BVDV), Pseudorabies, Bovine Rhinotracheitis, Feline Leukemia, Feline Picornavirus, Avian Influenza A Virus, Canine Distemper Virus, Rabies Virus and Porcine Respiratory & Reproductive Syndrome Virus (PRRSV). Add one (1) ounce of this product per gallon of water. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Apply solution with a cloth, mop, sponge or hand pump trigger sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid.

CONTACT TIME: Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.
