Avocados: Apply 1-2 gallons product per acre in 50-100 gallons of water.

Citrus: Apply 1 gallon product per acre plus 5-8 lbs. of lime per 100 gallons of water.

Walnuts: Apply 10-15 gallons product per acre at leaf fall.

Other Deciduous Trees: Apply 4-8 gallons product per acre at leaf fall.

SOIL APPLICATIONS

Barley, beans, corn, cotton, flax, milo, oats, peas, rice, sugar beets and wheat: Apply 8-14 gallons MONTEREY ZINC SULFATE SOLUTION 12% per acre and incorporate into the soil prior to planting.

Beets, carrots, melons, onions, tomatoes and others: Apply 8-12 gallons product per acre and incorporate into the soil prior to planting.
