
7- EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: TAKE OFF CONTAMINATED CLOTHING. RINSE SKIN IMMEDIATELY WITH PLENTY OF WATER FOR 15-20 MINUTES. CALL A POISON CONTROL CENTER OR DOCTOR FOR TREATMENT ADVICE.

IF INHALED: REMOVE VICTIM TO FRESH AIR. IF NOT BREATHING CALL 911 OR AN AMBULANCE, THEN GIVE ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION, PREFERABLY BY MOUTH TO MOUTH, IF POSSIBLE. CALL A POISON CONTROL CENTER OR DOCTOR FOR FURTHER TREATMENT ADVICE.

IF IN EYES: IMMEDIATELY FLUSH THE EYES WITH COPIOUS AMOUNT OF CLEAR, COOL RUNNING WATER FOR A MINIMUM 15 MINUTES. HOLD THE EYELIDS APART DURING THE FLUSHING TO ENSURE RINSING OF THE ENTIRE SURFACE OF THE EYES AND LIDS WITH WATER. CONTACT A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

IF INHALED: REMOVE VICTIM TO FRESH AIR. IF BREATHING HAS CEASED CLEAR THE VICTIM'S AIRWAY AND START MOUTH-TO-MOUTH ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION. IF BREATHING IS DIFFICULT, GIVE OXYGEN. CONTACT A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. BE SURE THAT THE CONTACT AREAS ARE CLEAN TO PREVENT CONTAMINATION OF THE RESCUER.

9- SPILL AND LEAK PROCEDURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN THE EVENT OF A SPILL OR DISCHARGE:

TAKE UP WITH SAND OR OTHER ABSORBANT MATERIAL AND PLACE IN CONTAINER FOR LATER DISPOSAL. WASH DOWN THE AREA WITH DETERGENT AND WATER. PREVENT LIQUID FROM ENTERING SEWERS, WATERWAYS OR LOW AREAS. CONSULT AN EXPERT ON THE DISPOSAL OF RECOVERED MATERIAL. EVACUATE PERSONNEL, THOROUGHLY VENTILATE AREA. USE SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS AND PROTECTIVE CLOTHING.

DISPOSAL PROCEDURE:

BURY OR INCINERATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS. ENSURE DISPOSAL IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH GOVERNMENT REQUIREMENTS AND ENSURE CONFORMITY OF LOCAL DISPOSAL REGULATIONS. NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES IMMEDIATELY.
