3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY:

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW: CAUTION! The product is an eye irritant and may cause corneal injury. The product is an environmentally hazardous substance. The product may be harmful if swallowed or inhaled. This herbicide is toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid breathing the mist.

PHYSICAL STATE: Liquid.

APPEARANCE: Pale tan or vellow.

ROUTE OF EXPOSURE: Inhalation, Skin Contact, Skin Absorption, Eye Contact.

IMMEDIATE EFFECTS:

Eye: Cause substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes.

Skin: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Propanil may cause a slight skin irritation. Propanil may

cause a sensitization by skin contact. Avoid contact with skin and clothing.

Ingestion: Harmful if swallowed. Do not take internally. **Inhalation:** Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing the mist.

CHRONIC OR DELAYED LONG-TERM: ACGIH, NTP, IARC or OSHA do not list this product as a carcinogen.

Medical Conditions Aggravated by Exposure: Propanil may cause upper respiratory irritation, dermatitis to the skin, or irritate sensitive eyes.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES:

GENERAL: Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

INHALATION: Move the exposed person to fresh air free from risk of further exposure. If the person is not breathing call 9-1-1, then apply rescue breathing and seek medical attention as soon as possible.

EYE CONTACT: Flush with clean, lukewarm water raising upper and lower eyelids at low pressure for 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes and continue to rinse the eyes. Seek medical attention if no relief.

SKIN CONTACT: Rinse area with clean water for 15-20 minutes. Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
