DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Legume Vegetable Lentil (<i>Lens esculenta</i>)	Stemphylium blight	6.0-15.5 (0.10-0.25)	Quadris applications should begin prior to disease development and continue throughout the season every 7-14 days following the resistance management guidelines. Use the higher rates under severe disease pressure. Applications may be made by ground, air or chemigation. An adjuvant may be added at specified rates. For rust, use of a non-ionic surfactant is recommended. Do not apply more than two sequential applications of Quadris or other Group 11 fungicides before alternation with a fungicide that is not in Group 11.

The user must refer to the federally approved Quadris Flowable Fungicide label and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.

The user should have this recommendation in their possession at the time of use.
