Apply **Trinity** at 1.0 to 2.0 fl ozs/1000 sq ft (43.6 to 87.1 fl ozs/A) for control of fairy ring in turfgrass. For other application instructions, follow intervals and comments associated with the instructions for controlling Brown patch, Cool weather/Yellow patch, and Brown ring patch on the **Trinity** container label.
