Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Actara will provide suppression of Western Flower Thrips on strawberries at the rate of 4.0 oz/A.

Use sufficient water volume and spray pressure to ensure thorough coverage of the foliage. Spray contact to the Western Flower Thrips is very important in making these applications successful.

Do not exceed 12.0 oz. of Actara (0.0.188 lb a.i.) per acre during a growing season.

Pollinator Precautions

- **Actara is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds.** Do not apply Actara or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are foraging in/or adjacent to the treated area.

The user must refer to the federally approved labels for the above noted product and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.

The user should have this recommendation in its possession at the time of use.
