Basil	Downy mildew <i>(Peronospora belbahrii)</i>	8.0 0.13	<p>Apply no more than two applications containing Micora per crop.</p> <p>One application may be made during the plug growing stage and one application may be made during the crop finishing stage.</p> <p>Begin applications prior to disease development and continue on a 7-10 day interval. Make no more than 2 consecutive applications before switching to another effective non-Group 40 fungicide. Use the shorter interval and/or higher rates under high pressure or when conditions are conducive to disease. Micora may be tank mixed with another fungicide labeled for downy mildew that has a different mode of action.</p> <p>The addition of a spreading/penetrating type adjuvant such as a non-ionic based surfactant or crop oil concentrate or blend is recommended.</p>
	Application: For best results, use sufficient water volume to provide thorough coverage. Micora may be applied by ground application or chemigation.

- Do not apply more than 16 fl oz of product/A/crop (0.26 lb a.i./A/crop).
- Do not apply within 1 day of harvest (1-day PHI).
